Still holding defensive sector. Sent contact patrol to 1st & 2nd Bns. Patrol consisted of 4 E.M. & a Jeep. On the return trip fr contacting these Bns. the Jeep was strafed by 4 planes bearing our own markings. 1 Pfc. was burned to death by gasoline. 1 Pfc. & 1 Pvt were wounded.
