Reference is made to your application for a Covernment bronze marker to be erected in memory of your son, the late Captain John Burk McCue, whose remains are interred in a United States Military Commetery in St. Laurent, France.

You are advised, Public Law 871, 80th Congress, authorizes the furnishing of Government headstones and markers for the graves of deceased members of the Armed Forces whose remains are interred therein. There is no authority to furnish a Government headstone or marker to be erected in a cemetery, as a memorial, when the remains of the veteran are not interred therein.

For your information, when a veteran's final burial takes place in a cemetery under Government control, either in the United States or a foreign country, the grave is permanently marker without any action on the part of the next of kin or the family of the decedent.

In view of the above, your application has been canceled.
