Dear Sir,

I refer to my letter to you dated 28th July, 1945, concerning your late son, Flight Sergeant Stanley Kevin Black, in which I informed you that further enquiries were being made by the Missing Research and Enquiry Service.

I have now to advise that a representative of that Service visited the Parish Cemetery of St. Jean de Daye, a village south of Garentan, and saw the grave, over which a cross bears the names of Sergeants Corner, Rooker, Wigham and Puckett, four members of the crew of your late son.

The representative made extensive enquiries concerning the fate of your son and Pilot Officer Warren. He interviewed a M. Cardin, at St. Jean de Daye, who sheltered your son for one day, and, at the latter's request, took him over to a neighbouring village where about 180 American parachutists had landed the previous day and were preparing to defend their position. About a week later, the enemy strongly attacked this village and most of the Americans were killed, some of their bodies, so the representative was informed, being cremated by the enemy on the spot. It is known that your son was with the defenders, and it must be regretfully assumed that he suffered the fate of the American parachutists.

On information supplied by your son, M. Cardin made an extensive search for Pilot Officer Warren, or signs of his parachute, without success. He informed the representative, however, that there might well have been five bodies in the wreckage of the plane, and this would account for Pilot Officer Warren. It is stated that your late son told M. Cardin that Pilot Officer Warren was the first to bale out, but this is considered improbable. He was the Captain of the crew and would remain until the last at his post; moreover, Flying Officer J. Drylie in his statement said, "Our aircraft was badly hit by flak and the bomb-aimer and myself had time to bale out. Of the others, I cannot say whether they baled out or not, as I was completely on my own when I reached the ground. Warren was unwounded and, in my opinion, would have a fair chance of getting out".

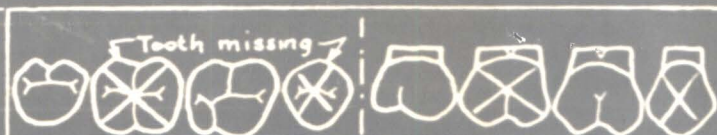


This dental chart is very important and should be filled in with great care. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by the numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws, the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspids (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions : Lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridge work, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found. 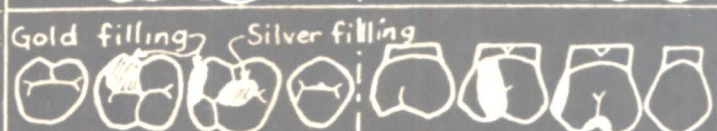

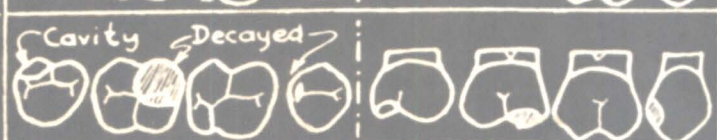
