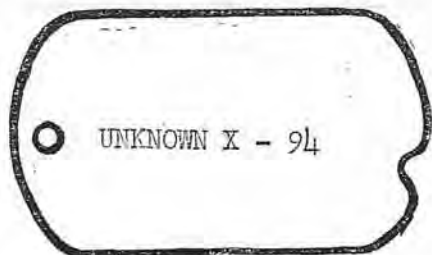

Reference letter 29 April 1947 from AGRC, ETA, reporting identity of Unknown X-97, Plot T, Row 7, Grave 140, USMC, Blosville, France, as F/Sgt. Stanley K. Black, Royal Australian Air Force. Items of personal effects listed as recovered from remains of the decedent, consists of French francs, one flag, one shilling, and two tags.

These items of personal effects were received at the Bureau in February 1945 marked with the identity of X-97 Blosville Cemetery; plot, row, and grave number was not known. Report concerning receipt of these effects was furnished OQMG 11 January 1946. Due to similarity in burial location, these personal effects forwarded to widow of Cpl. James M. Naff. Corporal Naff was originally interred as Unknown X-94, buried in Blosville Cemetery, Plot T, Row 7, Grave 132.

In view of the fact that widow of Corporal Naff has accepted the items of personal effects, action on our part to regain the effects is impracticable. Should inquiry be received at a later date, this discrepancy should be reported.
