RECORD OF EVENTS

FORWARD HOHELON; All 500th Paratrooper Battalion

18 Sept 44: Barkington Heath airfield, Btry loaded in CG-4A gliders and took off from airfield at 1230 hrs. Landed on and around 12 under intense small arm fire, at 1545 hrs, two gliders were reported to have crashed in sea, eight gliders landed in Germany, all equipment lost, 12 loads unaccounted for. Morale excellent, weather fair.

19 Sept 44: Btry assembled two guns and went into position at (7303 - 5430). Two officers and two EM joined Btry. Btry fired 32 rds 105mm Ammo on enemy targets; Morale excellent.

20 Sept 44: Btry fired 284 rds 105mm Ammo on enemy targets. Supported 2nd Bn 505th Preht Bn in attack on bridge across Waal river also gave fire support for the British Grenadier guards. Patriots served coffee, tea and apples to the Btry. 1 Off and 38 EM still unreported. Morale excellent, weather fair. 1 EM KIA, 1 EM reported KIA as of 18 Sept 44.

21 Sept 44. Btry moved to new position coordinates 7335A9 arrived at 0400 hrs. Btry fired 124 rds 105mm Ammo in support of 505th Preht Inf, S. B, of Groesbeck, Holland. Enemy planes over Btry area several times during the day. Btry issued German rations that were captured by the division. Morale excellent, weather fair. 1 Off and 38 EM still unaccounted for.

22 Sept 44: Btry fired 168 rds 105mm Ammo on enemy targets. Mortar shells landed in and about Btry Area. Morale excellent, weather fair.



RECORD OF EVENTS

FORWARD ECHELON

23 Sept 44: Btry fired 119 rds 105mm Ammo. Enemy shells dropped in and around Btry area. Btry position in good order. Morale excellent, weather rainy. No casualties.

BASE ECHELON
19 Sept to 23 Sept 44 incl. Usual camp duties.
