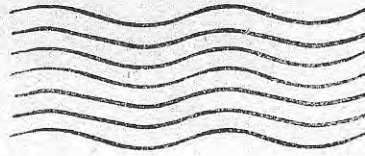

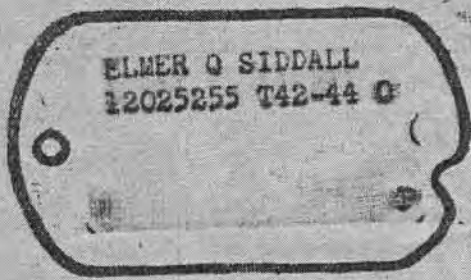

Corp. Siddall Of Moravia Is Missing

Mother Gets Message
~~That Paratrooper Saw~~
Action in France

Moravia, June 29.—Mrs. Ernest Siddall of R.D. 3 received a telegram from the War Department Wednesday that her son, Corp. E. Quentin Siddall is missing in action in France. Corp. Siddall was attached to a para-troop unit of the Army engineers. He is the youngest of her four sons in the service.

Corp. Siddall enlisted in 1941 and was inducted into the service July 1, his 18th birthday, when he had completed his junior year at Moravia High School, where he was entered as an agricultural student. He was active in baseball and considered a crack shot as member of the rifle team. He reported for basic training at Portland, Ore., and from there was transferred to Camp McCall, N.C. from here he entrained for overseas duty in February of this year.

Mrs. Siddall today expressed every hope of her son's safety. "The telegram was a terrible shock," she said, "but I somehow feel confident that Quentin is safe and I feel calmer now."

Three other sons are in the service, all enlisting in 1942; Pfc. Alan N. Siddall, who is training in gunnery at Laredo, Tex.; Iva Siddall, warrant officer at a field inspection office of air service, at Indianapolis, Ind., and Lt. Ewa Siddall, a navigator of the Army Air Force stationed in England. A fifth son, Carl, is at home working the farm alone.



Corp. Siddall's Death Attested

Information has now been received by Mr. and Mrs. Ernest C. Siddall from Headquarters, 307th Airborne Engineer Battallion, revealing the circumstances leading to the death of their son, E. Quentin Siddell on D-Day, 1944, who for five months carried a missing status and was later reported killed.



The letter reveals that Corporal Siddall volunteered to partake in an especially hazardous operation, and that investigation shows that his plane load of paratroops jumped on St. Mere Eglise, France, the first village on the continent to be liberated on June 6, 1944, and that all the men of his plane were killed due to enemy action.

The letter further states that the remains of Corporal Siddall were interred in a U. S. Military cemetery at Blosville, France on July 1st, 1944, the last rites being administered by a Protestant Chaplain. Ironically enough, July 1st is the date of his birth, and also the date on which he first enlisted in the U. S. Army in 1941, at the age of eighteen.

The Purple Heart was Posthumously awarded to Corporal Siddall, and it has been received by his parents.
