Dear Mr. Scarborough:

There has been received in this office from the Veterans Administration a receipted bill from the Sunnyside Mausoleum Company for services rendered incident to the interment of the remains of the late Private Carl W. Scarborough who died 23 August 1943 at Alliance, Nebraska, while on active duty with the United States Army.

The official records of this office show that the remains of Private Scarborough were prepared for burial and shipped to Compton, California, at the expense of the War Department. The records further show that \$45 toward interment expenses was paid to Morelands Mortuary, Compton, California in September, 1943. Since \$50 is the maximum amount which may be allowed toward interment expenses at destination, and \$45 has already been paid, you may be reimbursed in the amount of \$5 if you desire to write a letter to this office requesting reimbursement in this amount. Your claim would then be forwarded to the General Accounting Office recommending settlement.

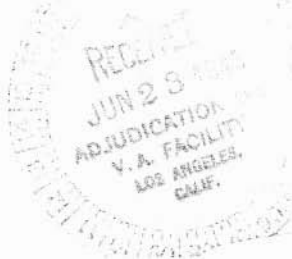
