The Division Command Post moved south of ETIENVILLE and south of the DOUVE River and was established at coordinates 286912.

508th Parachute Infantry Regiment

The regiment was passed through by 90th Infantry Division troops west of ST. SAUVEUR LE VICOMTE and moved south of the DOUVE River, closing into an assembly area southwest of LES MOITIERS EN BAUPTOIS by 1330 hours. The 3d Battalion launched a determined attack against PRETOT at 0600 hours and seized the town and took up defensive positions after a sharp, short battle. The Battalion was subjected to heavy artillery and mortar shelling throughout the day. At 1600 hours the Battalion moved to positions west of PRETOT and was relieved in place at 2330 hours by the 1st Battalion, 507th Parachute Infantry.
