

Pvt. Ausnehmer Killed in Action

Pvt. Herman Fred Ausnehmer, aged 20, of 339 Carroll St., was killed in action in Normandy June 6, the War Department has informed his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Earl H. Ausnehmer.

Private Ausnehmer was identified in a picture of invasion troops published in The Vindicator June 9. A son of a World War I veteran, he was born in Youngstown Feb. 18, 1924, attended South High School and was employed by General Fireproofing Co.

He entered service Feb. 13, 1943, trained at Camp Wheeler, Ga., and Camp Joyce Kilmer, N. J., and went overseas last November.

Besides his parents, Private Ausnehmer leaves a younger brother, Earl, and his grandmother, Mrs. Anna C. Rochow, at home, and his fiancée, Miss Mary Raduck, of Youngstown.

Memorial services will be held at 10:45 a. m. today in St. Paul Lutheran Church.

| behind prearranged schedule. Each section came under small arms, MG, & mortar fire while disembarking. Co had to wade through approximately 30 yds of water while fired upon by the enemy. Co was engaged in a fire fight with enemy strong points overlooking the beach for about 6 hours. 3 Sections were landed in 3rd Bn Sector where they aided in knocking out enemy beach defences. The surviving men remained with 3rd Bn & rejoined Co the following day. At 1230 hrs remainder of Co not with 3rd Bn was ordered to move 500 yds to the right where a break through had been established. Bn moved inland near Colleville. The Co because of loss of officers & in the process of reorganization remained with Bn furnished furnishing local security.
