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**SGT. MELVIN H. GRANGER, JR.,  
SERIOUSLY WOUNDED**

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Mrs. Louise L. Granger of Route 1, Halifax, has received a telegram from the War Department informing her that her son, Staff Sergeant Melvin H. Granger, Jr., was seriously wounded in action in France on the day of invasion, June 6th. Staff Sgt. Granger is a member of Company F.

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
