Tuesday, July 4

Attacked Hill 95 at 12:15, exposed all the way across open field. That's one I think the Germans won. They sure got enough of us, opened up on us with machine guns after we got right in the middle of the field. A hell of a lot of the boys got hit. Vashion, Swendson, DeLoach, Medford, Tanner killed, lots of others wounded, got 42 men left, two platoons of 21 men each. Put me back in Co. Hq. 300 o.p. Don't like that, help out some, finally got something to eat, moved to a defensive area dug in to the night, got me a P38.
