- 29 Dec 44: No change in position. Things are not too bad.
- 31 Dec 44: Ran a problem with tanks and 3 P-T D. Everything else ran without change.
- 1 Jan 45: Co moved west one mile to new area.
- 2 Jan 45: No change:
- 3 Jan 45: Moved out of area at 0500. Just after daylight, the Co advanced on small town. Enemy forces were strong. Took the town and advanced south about 1600 hr.
- 4 Jan 45: The company moved out at daylight. Advanced to edge of town (Arbrefontaine). Had a bit of a flight at the edge of town. Captured enemy Bn CO in American jeep and withdrew about 300 yds. Set up for the night.
- 5 Jan 45: Company held position S of town. Enemy zeroed in on our lines with artillery hit CP several times.
