RECORD OF EVENTS

May 29: Btry ate breakfast at 0530. At 0900 all combat equipment left camp area by motor convoy. At 1300 the remainder of the btry excluding the rear echelon dressed in full field equipment and marched a mile to the train for the new camp, which was reached at 1930. Men were quartered in tents. Weather: inclement and warm. Morale: good. Distance covered about 100 miles.

May 30: Btry performed guard and usual camp duties and other time was spent in athletics. At 1500 and 1700 a movie was had. At 1900 Btry played Btry A and won 5 - 4. (contd on the back)
