May 29/44: Forward Echelon: 2 Off and 9 in left Huttet camp by Mtr convey at 0915 hrs arrived at Velford Park Airfield, Berkshire England at 1830 hrs. Distance traveled Approx 92 miles. 7 Off & 63 EM left Huttet camp 1230 hrs. marched to Theddingworth and entrained at 1330 hrs. Arrived at Newbury 1820 hrs. Entrucked for Velford Park Airfield, Berkshire, England arriving at 1930hrs. 1 Off & 1 EM fr Huttet camp arrived by Morot Vehicle at Velford Park Airfield at 2030 hrs. 1 Off & 5 EM - Advance Detail to duty with forward Echelon.

May 30/44: Forward Echelon received instructions in ditching Horsa Gliders. & Usual camp duties.

May 31/44: Forward Echelon. Usual camp duties.

June 1/44: Forward Echelon: Part of Btry loaded Horsa Gliders. All N.C.O.'s briefed on mission & usual camp duties.

June 2/44: Forward Echelon: Part of Btry loaded Horsa Gliders. All privates briefed on mission. Usual camp duties.

May 29 to June 2/44 Incl. Base Echelon: usual camp duties.
