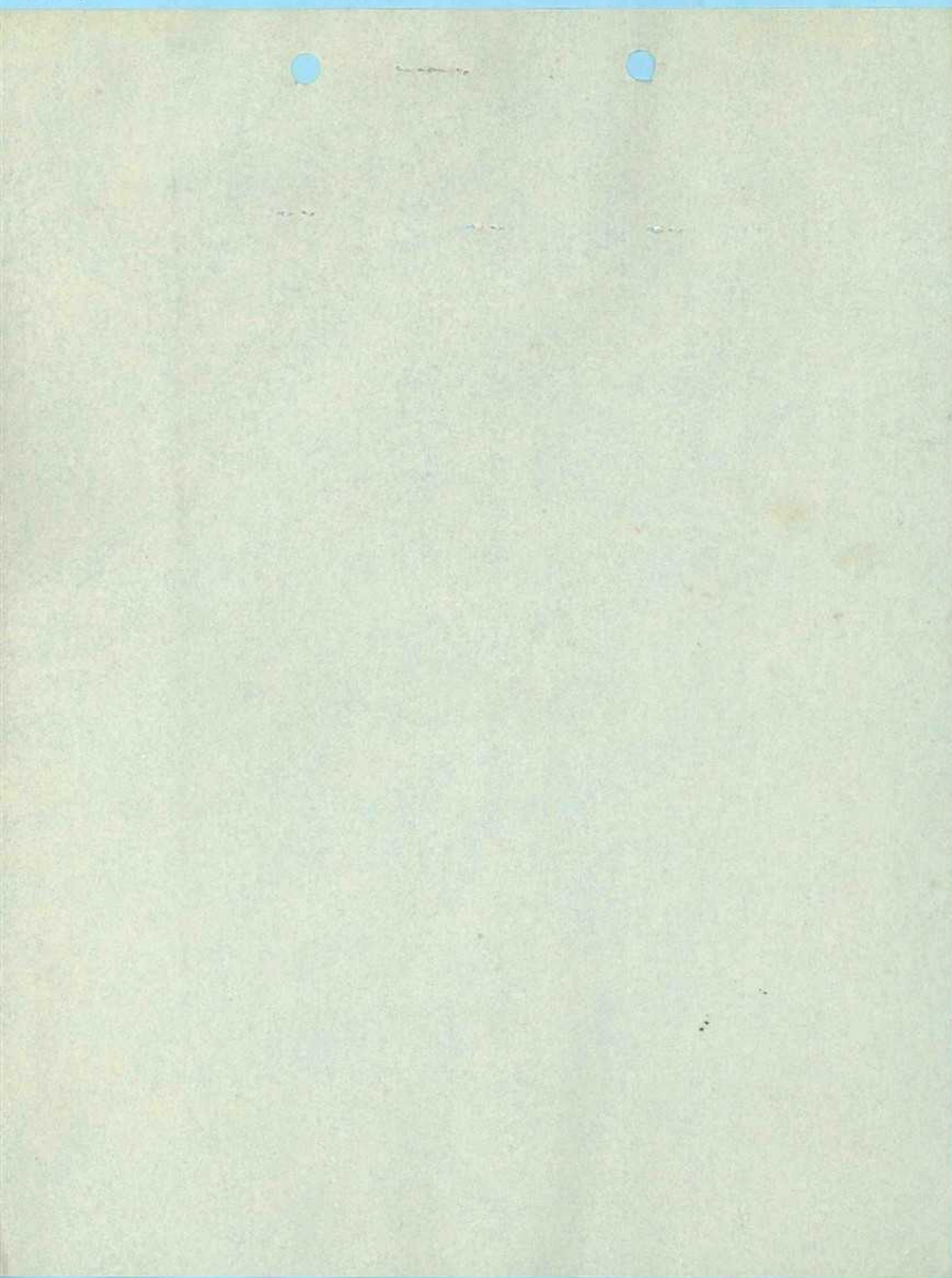

3. This soldier's service record, WD AGO Form No. 24, shows that he was killed in action on 24 June 1944.
4. Retained copies of morning reports of Private Fulmer's organization, Company C, 502d Parachute Infantry, for the month of June 1944, show that his unit landed in France at 0100 hours, 6 June 1944, and was engaged in combat from 6 June 1944 thru 30 June 1944. 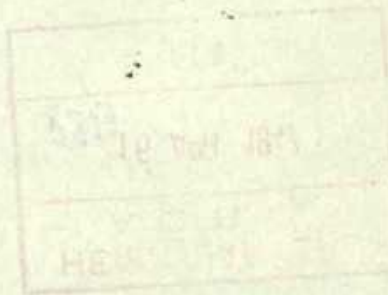

Acknowledgment is made of your letter of recent date requesting information concerning the late Private Edward L. Fulmer.

It is regretted that due to security regulations the geographical location of the place of burial of the remains of Private Fulmer cannot be disclosed at this time. You may be assured, however, that his remains were temporarily interred in one of our well established American Military Cemeteries in the area in which he was serving, with a Protestant Ceremony conducted at the grave by an Army Chaplain. The cemetery is well cared for and under immediate supervision of our military authorities. A temporary marker, with a fitting inscription thereon, has been erected, and the grave properly recorded.

A notation has been made on the official records of this office that it is your desire to have the remains of your friend returned to the United States for final interment, if possible, after the war. All expenses incident to the preparation and shipment of the remains to the place thus designated by the legal next of kin will be borne by the Government.

The remains of Private Fulmer were definitely identified as two identification tags were found with the body, one of which was interred with the remains and the other attached to the marker on the grave for future identification.

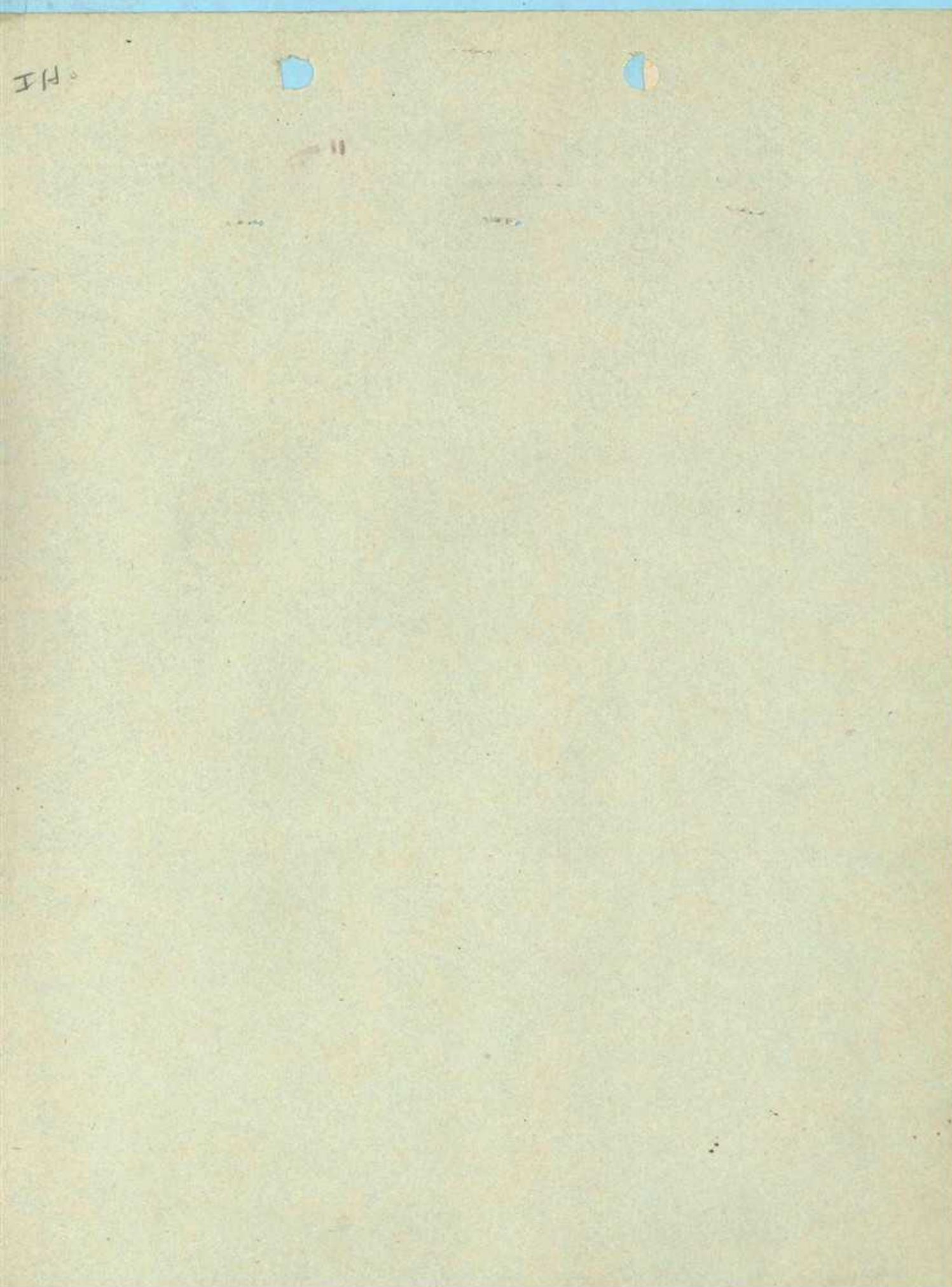

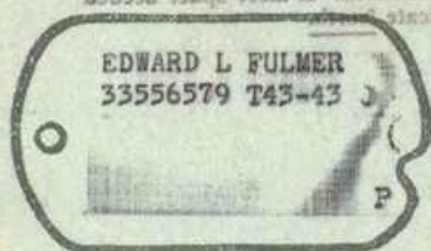

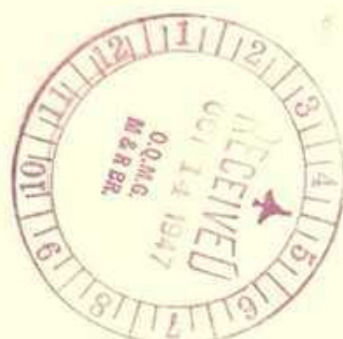
