30 Sept/44 - Attacked woods SE of Groesback ID at 0800, heavy resistance and casualties. Advanced 500 yds, organized defensive position.

1 Oct/44 - Relieved by Bn 505, moved to bivouse area near Mook, reorganized.
2 Oct/44 - Attacked mile east of Mook, 1D at 0530, advanced 1000 yards, held up by German strong points, reopened attack at 2130 and moved short of objective by 300 yards.
3 Oct/44 - Popping up and strengthening positions, unsuccessfull enemy counterattack at 2000.
4 Oct/44 - Withdrew at 0100 to 2d Bn lines

4 Oct/44 - Withdrew at 0100 to 2d Bn lines relieved by Bn at 0430, moved to bivous area north of Grossbeck.

5 Oct/44 - Remained in bivouse, received mail, etc.

6 Oct/44 - Remained in bivouae area in Division Reserve. Improved camouflage of area. Some enemy artillery about 300 yards from area. C-rations every meal, Bn mess. Rifle and weapons inspection. Morale improving. Weather clear and cool.
