- 11 Jun 44: CP moved approximately 1 mile NW.
- 12 Jun 44: 1 O & 11 EM, demolitionists, reported in fr mission with 1st Bn.
- 13 Jun 44: Upon being relvd fr the front line the Co moved to Picaupille for Division Reserve.
- 14 Jun 44: No change.
- 15 Jun 44: No change.
- 16 Jun 44: CP moved several times during this period. Town of Ste Sauveur fell & CP again set up.
- 17 Jun 44: CP still set up in Ste Sauveur.
- 18 Jun 44: CP still remained at Ste Sauveur. Care & cleaning of equipment.
- 19 Jun 44: CP moved from Ste Sauveur to Ettenville, where care & cleaning of equipment was still in progress.
- 20 Jun 44: No change.
- 21 Jun 44: 2 squads demi went to 3rd Bn to clear mines and booby traps.
- 22 Jun 44: Advanced elements of CP moved forward at 1500 hr. Demi had returned from mine sweeping at 0400 & again departed for 2nd Bn at 1300 hr. Rear CP remained intact.
- 23 Jun 44: Left cross-roads at Ettenville for destination approx. 2 mi fr rear CP.
- 24 Jun 44: 19 demi returned to CP after being relvd.
- 25 Jun 44: Except for bombing & strafing by our own airforce, things were on the quiet side.
