Moved to debarkation point, loaded onto LCA's & were lowered to the water at 0325. Landed on the coast of France in the vicinity of Colleville Sur Mer at 0700 hrs. H hour was originally scheduled for 0630 but heavy seas & poor visibility caused the assault waves to land 30 minutes late. All naval shelling had lifted and there was no supporting fires on the beach defenses at all when the Co. landed. The supporting tanks were also late, coming 20 mins. after the assault waves had landed. The company at this time consisted of the 1, 2, 3, 5 & Hq. sections. The 4th section had capsized in the heavy seas shortly after debarking from the transport. The landing crafts beached just short of several rows of underwater obstacles. The company (Cont)

waded ashore and crossed 200 yds. of open beach under intense enemy machine gun, rifle, mortar, artillery and anti tank weapon fire. This brought the company into the shelter of a vertical cliff approximately 15 ft. at the highest point. The section leaders immediately reorganized their sections. The 1st section boat had been hit numerous time by artillery shells & many of the men were missing. On the beach, the company aid men distinguished themselves by their cool & effective treatment of the wounded while under fire. The assault on the beach strong points were begun immediately and the company began to push inland from around the west edge of the cliff. The company commander was seriously wounded when he was hit by fire

from enemy anti-tank weapons. The exec. off immediately took command of the company. The second section under Lt. Monteith was ordered to push up a small draw & engage pill boxes on the left strong point. The 3rd section, under Lt. Williams was to advance on the right of the 2nd section & the 5th section under Lt. Marincic was to follow the 3rd section. The remainder of the 1st section under Lt. Klenk passed around the right flank, made contact with elements of the 116th Inf. & assaulted the right strong point, which was the original company mission. In this maneuver, Lt. Klenk combined the remnants of his own section & parts of the 116th Inf. teams. Lt. Klenk then sent a 5 man patrol out to clear a path through mine-fields & barbed wire obstacles. (Contd)

This patrol pushed forward making progress until they became embroiled in a hand grenade exchange with some Jerries who were in position on their left flank. A destroyer layed in with direct fire & Sgt. Mansfield moved in with re-enforcements & the enemy was cleaned out. A number of enemy were killed & wounded and 15 taken prisoner. The rest of the company reached the high ground in the rear of the defenses & set up a hasty defense. The enemy conducted a local counter attack but it was beat off with few casualties. In the meantime a patrol from the 3rd section reconnoitered a route into Le Gd Hameau & reported back. Upon their return the rest of the Co. moved forward into Le Gd Hameau & re-organized and then moved 600 yds (Cont)
