RECORD OF EVENTS
 At 0500 hrs attack began to cross Kile River. Heavy Enemy resistance encountered. The platoons of Co crossed river followed by rest of Bn. Heavy enemy fire forced entire Bn to withdraw to high ground across river. Casualties were very high. Morale was low. Unit reorganized and reequipped with arms and ammunition at 2200 hrs.
