At 0830 troops withdrew to the rear 1000 yards while appr 3000 medium and heavy bombers bombed to the front of our positions. A few fell short but no casualties resulted to Co "G" Troops returned to original positions at 1215. A few prisoners walked into our lines. At 2200 the Battalion crossed the road.
