Services for Cpl. Robert P. Smith will be held Saturday at 1 p. m. in the funeral home of Joseph H. Murray & Son, 408 Cooper street. Burial will be in Harleigh cemetery.

Corporal Smith was killed in France on D Day, June 6, 1944. He was a member of the 116th Infantry, 29th Division. He had been in the army since May, 1942. He was 23 at the time of his death.

A former student at the Woodrow Wilson High school, he lived at 618 State street. Before entering the service he was employed by the Knox Gelatin Co.

Surviving is his mother, Mrs. Avis Smith, of the State street address.
