ing since June 18 in France, would be found alive, were shattered for Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Robb when news of his death in action on that date was received. The officer perished while leading his heavy mortar battalion into battle in Normandy. He had been overseas a year and a half but this was the first action he had seen.

Memorial mass will be held for Richard, a former St. Vincent's high school and John Carroll university student, on Monday at 8 a. m. at St. Joseph's Catholic church in the Falls. His widow is the former Betty O'Malley of Geneva, N. Y.
