Missing since June 23, as reported in The News July 21, Pfc. Franklin C. Heyer, 21, son of Mrs. Beatrice Heyer of 84½ Northland Ave., is known to have been killed while on a reconnaissance patrol in France on that date. He was graduated from Burgard Vocational High School and was employed by Chevrolet Motors before he was inducted 18 months ago. Besides his mother, he is survived by two brothers, Seaman (1st Class) Charles H. Heyer, USNR, and Robert Heyer.
