RECORD OF EVENTS

7 June 44 Co arose 0300 marched to Marshalling area and left same 0430. Co boarded gliders 0600, took off 0730. Arrived at destination 1300. Co. marched allnite to maneuver into Position for an attack on enemy.

10 June 44 Co took up new position 2300 and holding, preparing for a ~~XH~~ take-off.

11 June 44 Left Defensive position in attack 1000-reorganized 1800-attacked 1900- took up defensive position at 2300.

14 June 44 Left Bivouac area for new position. On the approach March Co. was halted several times due to shell fire. Arrived new position 2300 and waited for further orders.

15 June 44 Co. still continued to push West on Approach March being held up occasionally by enemy small arms fire.
