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Lt Howard Gielow - Co 'I', 501st PIR

In a letter to Mike Finn on December 16, 1987, Howard Gielow wrote the following:

"Your October 30 note makes reference to Bob Harrison. Bob was not killed in Wordin. After the Germans over-ran his position he hid in an attic, was betrayed by the occupants of the house and was captured. Later he and I were re-united at the Hemmelberg Prisoner of War camp. Bob and I were close friends ever since we first met at Toccoa. The second day after I arrived at the camp I was confined to the sick ward of the American portion of the camp and Bob was great in coming to visit me. Later I was transferred to a hospital in the Serbian portion of the camp and again Bob was faithful about sneaking in to see me. During the last two times he visited me he spoke of making plans to escape. On each occasion I did my best to dissuade him, but was unsuccessful. He managed to break out, but one of the Serbiens told me that Bob had been captured a short distance from the camp and had been killed."
