RECORD OF EVENTS

June 6: About 2 miles east of Ste Mere Eg-
lise France - Btry left Camp Yembury England
at about 1900 rode to airfield in trucks and
loaded in Gliders ready to leave on mission.
At 2037 Btry left airfield, flew to and
landed in France behind enemy lines, weather
Fair Morale: Good. Distance covered in all,
about 150 miles.

June 7: About 2 miles east of Ste Mere Eg-
lise France - Btry spent most of day recover-
ing equipment and evacuating wounded. At about
1800 Btry was assembled with the Bn. Equip-
ment not yet recovered: 3 Howitzers, 5 Jeeps
