(9 June 44 cont'd) back once by strong counter attack. Reinforced by 120 men from 507th Parachute Infantry and retook the area. Set up a line to hold what we had. Morale good, weather clear.

12 June 1944: Company moved up to forward position. Usual camp duties.

14 June 1944: Company moved forward into Effaville, encountered strong enemy resistance. After pushing forward approximately 1500 yards was relieved by the 1st Battalion 325th Glider Infantry.

15 June 1944: Toward evening we passed thru the 1st Battalion 325th Glider Infantry to resume the attack. Pushed on to Crosville.

10 June AA: (France) 90th Div moved in, using our front line as their line of departure at 0530 to continue advance. En remained in same position. Morale good, weather clear. Still a few snipers in our area.

11 June AA: (France) Three Seaborne EM joined unit. Company withdrew to Bivouac area 2500 yards from Aspreville. Men clean up and rest. Morale good, weather warm.
