13 June 44 Crossed the Daube River at Dawn after a 15 min Arit Barrage. Marched to Baupte, went into the attack of Baupte at 1630 hr. Hard fighting until 2000 hr. Dig in for the night.

16 June 44 Crossed the Daube River from Baupte to Pickerville and into Regimental Area.

17 June 44 Moved from assembly area to St Sauveor Le Vicomte and into a defensive area while going into the area, Swan was Killed.

18 June 44 In defensive position outside of St Sauveor Le Vicomte. Sending out patrols into area of our front.

19 June 44 Sent out two more patrols, no action. Word came for men to prepare to move out at once. Moved to Battalion Assembly area at 1845 hr.
