Dear Sir or Madam,

I am writing to ask if you will assist me in locating the IDPF's and addresses of the next-of-kin of two 9th U.S. Division officers and two enlisted men who were killed in Normandy, France on 17 June 1944 and one enlisted man who was killed the following day.

They are:

Lt Col Richard E Buchanan	0-305700 HQ SP TRPS 9 DIV
Major Basil Shirley	0-302192 DIV ARTY 9 DIV
Cpl David J Brogner	32056453 HQ CO 9 DIV

My Father, Capt Henry N Blanchard Jr, Signals Officer, 9th Division, was killed in the same incident, and I am planning to set up a small memorial, with the help of the local French people, at the spot where they died, in June this year. It would therefore be helpful if you were able to assist me by sending to me copies of their IDPF's and also in locating the next-of-kin of Lt Col Richard Buchanan and Maj Basil Shirley, as well as of Cpl David Brogner, who escaped the incident on 17 June, only to be killed the next day, 18 June 1944.

I will, of course be willing to pay any fees required to obtain these details. If you accept payment by credit card, to speed up this process, I hereby authorise you to debit my Mastercard No. 5435 5600 0169 9237 Expiry date 05/98 for the appropriate sum, not to exceed \$150, without further authority from me.

The three officers and Cpl Brogner were all buried in France, but may have living relatives in the US or elsewhere. I attach the details of Lt Col Buchanan, Maj Shirley and Cpl Brogner, furnished to me by the office at the U.S. Cemetery at Colville-sur-Mer (Omaha Beach) Normandy, France.

In addition, I would be grateful for copies of the IDPF's and any other similar information regarding the next-of-kin of the two enlisted men, who were also killed in the same incident on 17 June 1944, and whose bodies were returned to the U.S. for burial (according to the Battle Monuments Commission). They are:

32065876 PFC Valentine Hal Fose, Hq Co 9th Division (Defense Platoon Driver)
Pvt Cecil M Barnes, 9th Signal Company, 9th Division (Driver)

I regret that I do not have details of their service numbers. My sole purpose in attempting to locate living relatives of these soldiers is to inform them of my plans, so that they may have the opportunity to attend the planned ceremony in June of this year, should they wish to do so, to honour those who died. I am in correspondence with the 9th Division Official Historian, Lt Col Henry 'Red' Phillips, and the 9th Signal Company Association.

If you can assist me in locating any living relatives of those who died, I would be grateful. Alternatively if you are unable, for reasons related to security of information, to give me their addresses, I would be very grateful if you would pass on a copy of this letter to any relatives, so that they might contact me, if they wish. This is in response to your request dated August 8, 1997, for World War II casualty information pertaining to five individuals.


Members of the public request U.S. Government documents and information under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). Your request has been determined to be a FOIA request.

Under the FOIA, as amended by Congress in October 1986, and the DOD implementing guidelines, you must make a fee declaration indicating your willingness to pay applicable governmental fees. Your request is administratively closed since there is no fee declaration.

You are considered an "all others" requester. As such you pay search fees over two hours (clerical search: \$12.00 per hour; professional search: \$25.00 per hour; executive search: \$45.00 per hour) and duplication cost for over 100 records at \$.15 per copy. It has been estimated that the FOIA fee for processing your request would be approximately \$60.00-\$75.00 U.S. dollars.

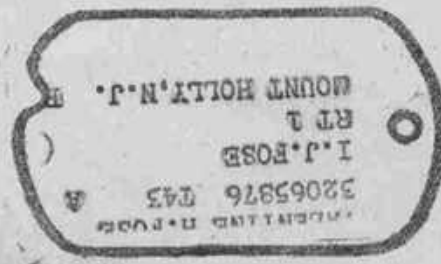
