Pfc. Oleski was mortally wounded during action on the Cherbourg peninsula in France on June 12. His parents have been advised.

Pvt. Oleski entered service Dec. 19, 1942 and trained at Camp Barkley, Texas, and Fort Dix, N. J. He was on desert maneuvers in California before sailing for England last April. His last furlough at home was in January.

Before entering service he assisted his father in the operation of a cafe at 1102 E. 9th st.

Surviving are his parents; two sisters, Martha and Mrs. Gertrude Zamrowski, and four brothers, Raymond, Leonard, Walter, Jr., and Jerome, all of Erie.
