**KILLED IN FRANCE** — Pvt. Alvin Anderson (above), 25, was reported killed in action in France June 16, according to notification from the War Department received by his sister, Mrs. Agnes B. Mauldin, Uniontown. Pvt. Anderson joined the Army Dec. 4, 1941, and had been overseas 19 months. Survivors include four sisters, Mrs. Mauldin, Mrs. Idell Gill, Mrs. B. E. Gill and Mrs. Alma Gill, all of Uniontown, and three brothers, Sidney Anderson, Uniontown; Agnew Anderson, Tuscaloosa, and Ellis Anderson, Siltaria.
