RECORD OF EVENTS

30 Sep 44 the company left its bivouac area at Coord 744-536 as per map of Holland 1:25,000 at approx 0400 hrs and moved up to a forward assembly area at coord 742-517 and at 0715 hrs crossed the LD in an attack on an azimuth of 145 degrees. G Co 401st Gli Inf on the right, K Co on the left. A heavy concentration of artillery was laid down preparatory to the jump off. Our troops came under a heavy concentration of mortar & artillery fire from the enemy which caused us a heavy toll of casualties. The terrain in this sector was very heavy woods with thick under growth which made contact between companies almost impossible. consequently the 2 companies became separated. The 2nd Plat of Co F which led the attack drove through so rapidly that they became separated from the rest of the company and

by heavy fire from all automatic weapons and rifles on the line. The company suffered some casualties from enemy shelling due to our position being in this heavy wooded area. Enemy shelling was very effective, being mostly tree bursts. 1 Oct 44 activity on the front was confined mostly to shelling from both sides. At approx 1400 hrs Co I 505 Pch Regt relieved Co F of this position. The Co as part of the Bn moved from this area at approx 1530 hrs to an area at coord 723-527 arriving at approx 1730 hrs. Bed rolls were brought forward to this area and the men were given an opportunity to get some much needed sleep. Moral remained very good despite the conditions the men had been subjected to.
