This manner of acknowledging receipt and replying to your recent letter pertaining to the late Pfc. James Toogood is being used due to the large number of inquiries received in this office in response to a letter written to many next-of-kin by the Commanding Officer, Ft. Worth QM Depot and in order to hasten our reply to you.

The records pertaining to your loved one are now on file in this office; however, it cannot be determined when the remains will arrive in the United States or at this depot to be delivered for final burial. You may be assured that any requests previously submitted by you to the Quartermaster General, Washington, D.C. or the Fort Worth QM Depot that were approved and are contained in the records will be complied with.

When information is received that the remains are enroute to the United States, we will immediately dispatch a telegram to you which will contain the delivery instructions; you will be requested to acknowledge receipt of the telegram and furnish such other information as may be necessary.

If final burial is in a private cemetery, not less than three days prior to forwarding the remains from this office, your funeral director will be advised by telegram of the exact date and hour of arrival at destination, with request to immediately notify you.

If final burial is in a national cemetery, the superintendent of the national cemetery will arrange with you by telegram the date and hour of the services in sufficient time for you to attend.

This office deeply appreciates your anxiety and every possible effort will be made to hasten the delivery of the remains of your loved one when received here.

We trust this information will be a source of consolation to you in this hour of sorrow.

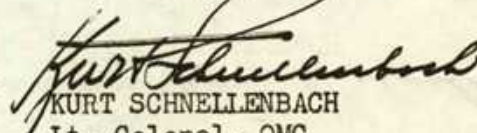
Dear Mrs. Toogood:

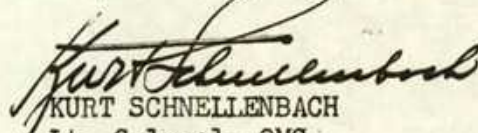

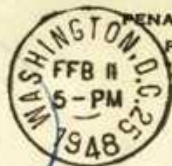

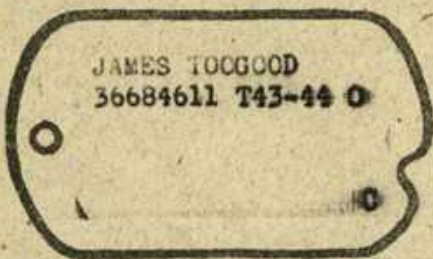
