9 June 1944: Company left assembly area at 0600. Started crossing canals at 1030, cleared two road crossings, pushed (over)

(9 Jun 44 cont'd) back once by strong counter attack. Reinforced by 120 men from 507th Parachute Infantry and retook the area. Set up a line to hold what we had. Morale good, weather clear.

12 June 1944: Company moved up to forward position. Usual camp duties.

14 June 1944: Company moved forward into Etienville, encountered strong enemy resistance. After pushing forward approximately 1500 yards were relieved by the 1st Battalion 325th Glider Infantry.

15 June 1944: Toward evening we passed thru the 1st Battalion 325th Glider Infantry to resume the attack. Pushed on to Crossville.
