These men, from the Medical Detachment, *** Parachute Infantry while under heavy enemy mortar, artillery, and small arms fire, with utter disregard for their personal safety, did repeatedly go forward to treat and evacuate the wounded, on many occasions, being within 50 yards of enemy tanks attempting to overrun the position. Their courage and devotion to duty reflect credit upon themselves and upon the Army of the United States.
