BODY OF WAR CASUALTY WILL ARRIVE WEDNESDAY

FUNERAL OF PFC FRANCIS E. ELVIDGE WILL BE HELD FROM PARENTS' HOME ON FRIDAY AFTERNOON.

Peckville, Feb. 2.—The body of PFC Francis E. Elvidge, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Elvidge, 408 Hickory Street, Peckville, who was killed in action in France on July 29, 1944, will arrive in Scranton at the Lacka-

wanna Station at 1:47 o'clock Wednesday afternoon.

Members of A. Pierson Hurd Post No. 327, American Legion; Shopa-Davey Post No. 6082, Veterans of Foreign Wars, and Blakely Borough police will escort the body to the home.

A former Times carrier, Private Elvidge was a Blakely High School graduate and was employed by the Ray Matthews Service Station, Peckville, when he entered the army in July, 1943. He went overseas in January, 1944. He was a member of the Christian and Missionary Alliance Church, Peckville.

Private Elvidge is survived, in addition to his parents, by four sisters, Mrs. Charlotte Wlozowski, Elizabeth, N. J.; Lieutenant Bessie, an army nurse at Camp Hood, Tex.; Sally and Dorothy, at home, and two brothers Oscar, at home, and William, Peckville.

The funeral will be held from the home Friday afternoon with services at 2:30 o'clock in charge of Rev. W. C. Neff and Rev. H. L. Jennings. Burial, Prospect Cemetery.
