**RECORD OF EVENTS**

7 June 44: 0645 Flew in gliders from Upottery Field, England, landed near Font du Mont, France about 0850. Weather fair.

13 June 44: Marched from assembly area near Picauville to assembly area northwest of Etienville, France. Weather fair.

14 June 44: Left assembly area northwest of Etienville. Attacked and took high ground, continued the attack west along the Douve River.

15 June 44: Continued attack west along Douve River through Grosville and Ranville, France.
