RECORD OF EVENTS

7 Jan/45 Left secondary defensive positions at 0430. Moved out from LD at 0630. Received enemy small arms fire at 0755. Continued to move about 1800 yards from LD when Bn was held up by Enemy small arms and tanks. Suffered number of ~~XX~~ casualties from enemy mortars and artillery. Company failed to make objective due to heavy losses and strong opposition. Heavy snowfall. Morale Non-Existent.
