

Dear Mr. Starr:

I am writing you relative to the previous letter from this office in which you were regretfully informed that a Finding of Death had been made in the case of your son, Sergeant Donald R. Sterr, Infantry, and that the presumptive date of his death had been established as 1 October 1945.

The records of the Department of the Army are being amended to show that Sergeent Starr was killed in action on 30 September 1944 in Kielberg Forest, Holland. This change in status from presumed dead to killed in action is based on burial information recently received. You no doubt, by this time, have received a letter from The Quartermeaster General concerning the disposition of your son's remains.

Pursuant to the provisions of Public Law 490, 77th Congress, 7 March 1942, as amended, official reports will now be issued by the Department of the Army which will indicate the actual date of his death as that shown above. The issuence of this official Report of Death will not affect any payment or settlement of accounts which has been made on the basis of the Finding of Death.

My continued sympathy is with you in the great loss you have sustained.





Dear Mr. Starr:

Our office promised to communicate with you further upon receipt of information concerning your son, the late Sergeant Donald R. Starr.

At this time I may inform you that the official report of burial discloses that his remains were originally buried in an isolated grave in Keikberg Forest, Holland, but were later disinterred by our American Graves Registration Personnel and moved to a more suitable location. His remains have been properly identified as a result of a subsequent investigation and I am, therefore, gratified to inform you the report discloses further that the remains of your son are now resting in Plot DD, Row 10, Grave 242, in the United States Military Cemetery Neuville-en-Condroz, Belgium.

This cemetery is located nine miles southwest of Liege, Belgium, and is under the constant care and supervision of our government and, you may be interested to know, has been designated as a permanent American Hilitary Cemetery dedicated in grateful remembrance of our World War II Dead.

Our records reveal that the identification of the remains of your son was established by the favorable comparison of tooth charts made for the deceased with those maintained in Army dental records for your son. Comparison was also made of physical characteristics with favorable results. His identification is further substantiated by the type of clothing found on the remains which is in agreement with the branch of service to which your son was assigned. Furthermore, the paratroopers boots, size 10B, which were found on the deceased are in agreement with your son's branch of service and with his shoe size as shown in Army records. 

This dental chart is very important and should be filled in with great care. There are 32 teeth to be accounted for, as shown by the numbers on the chart. Beginning at the middle line in both upper and lower jaws, the teeth are arranged symmetrically on either side and classed as incisors (cutting teeth), cuspids or canines (tearing teeth), bicuspids (chewing teeth), and molars (principal chewing teeth). An examination should be made and findings charted to cover the following basic conditions: Lost teeth, crowned teeth, bridge work, fillings, caries (cavities of decay), dentures (plates), and any deformity of jaws found. NARRATIVE

Disinterment of two (2) bodies at Mook-Middelaar area in the Koningsbosch forest, proved to be two (2) paratroopers.

The first remains which were disinterred consisted of a complete disarticulated body. Found with these remains was a comb, toothbrush, three (3) English coins and a pen knife. Clothing consisted of 0.D. uniform, pieces of cotton underwear, pieces of field jacket, and also helmet liner and paratrooper boots. Head and teeth present. No flesh on this body. These remains were evacuated to C.I.P. under evacuation number IZ - 1451.

The second remains which were disinterred and evacuated to C.I.P. under evacuation number I2-1452 consisted of a complete disarticulated body, with head and teeth present. Also found with remains was a U.S. Army whistle, cartridge, belt, pieces of O.D. uniform, pieces of field jacket and paratrooper boots, also a silk (piece of green parachute) scarf and cotton underwear. These remains seemed to have been given first aid for aid bandages were found to have been in and around the chest and stomach area amidst the bones. No flesh found with these remains.

It is believed that the two (2) unknowns mentioned in case were killed approximately September or October 1944, which is the time of the battle in this area.

Both graves have been thoroughly searched by me, and also the surrounding areas. Both these graves have been found in wooded area, and were found by forest workers while digging holes for replanting of other trees.

The items are forwarded in order that you may act as gratuitous bailee in caring for them pending the return of the owner, who has been reported missing in action. In the event he later is reported a casualty, and I sincerely hope he never is, it will be necessary that the property be turned over to the person or persons legally entitled to receive it.

When delivery has been made, I shall appreciate your acknowledging receipt by signing one copy of this letter in the space provided below, and returning it to this Bureau. For your convenience, there is inclosed an addressed envelope which needs no pestage.

I regret the circumstances prompting this letter, and wish to express my hope for the safe return of your son.
