

Reference is made to your letter concerning your son, Private First Class Frank P. Koonts, who was killed in action in France on 25 June 1944, the date on which he was previously reported missing in action.

Your earnest desire to learn all the details of the heroic action in which your son served his country is fully appreciated. It is sincerely regretted that no further information is available in this office other than that conveyed in previous correspondence. The many heroic deeds of individual soldiers were not always fully recorded as the tremendous movements of many men and much equipment were over large battle areas. I wish to advise you, however, since your son's records have been transferred to Demobilized Personnel Records Branch, Rec. Adm. Center, AGO, 4300 Goodfellow Boulevard, St. Louis, Missouri, your letter is being forwarded to that office for direct reply to you, in the event additional information is available.

I wish to advise you that the records of the War Department show the home address of Chaplain Gerald J. Rabe, 0532812, to be as follows: 20 Linden Park, Buffalo, New York.

The Quartermaster General, Washington 25, D. C., has jurisdiction over all matters pertaining to the return of the remains to the United States of our military personnel who die overseas and I am, therefore, forwarding a copy of your letter to that official for direct reply to your inquiry regarding this matter.

I realize how futile any words of mine may be to assuage your grief but I trust that the knowledge of your son's heroic sacrifice in action may be a source of sustaining comfort.

I am writing this letter to get any information on the death of our son, Frank P. Koontz; 3 696 393, killed in action in France on June 25, 1944, who was a member of Co. B, 22 Inf. at the time of his death. Two years have almost past and I have had no information other than his death notice and the place of burial. If there is any information that would be of any satisfaction please send it to me. I have received one letter from Chaplain Gerald J. Rabe of the 22 Inf. If it would be possible to have the home address of Chaplain Rabe it would be possible to get some information from him.

I understand the Government at this time are making preparations to return to this country the men that were lost in action. Please send the necessary paper so I can be assured of any early return of our son's body.





Dear Mr. Koontz:

Your letter to The War Department concerning your son, the late Private First Class Frank P. Koonts, has been referred to this office.

The official Report of Burial discloses that the remains of your son were interred in Plot E, Row 2, Grave 26, in the United States Military Cemetery, Blosville, located twenty-five miles southeast of Cherbourg, France.

The War Department has now been authorized to remove the remains of our honored dead, at Government expense, to the final resting place which next of kin may designate.

When the necessary verification of records has been completed, a letter with an information pamphlet and a "Request for Disposition" form attached will be mailed to you. The "Request for Disposition" form, when properly filled out, will constitute the formal expression of your detailed desires as next of kin. Until you receive these forms, therefore, it will not be necessary for you to communicate with this office regarding this subject, unless you desire to report any change of address.

As you probably know, the supply of steel for the manufacture of caskets, is at present uncertain. Without this essential item, the projected movement of remains cannot properly be initiated. This fact and the necessity for complete coordination of movement in many parts of the world make it impossible, at this time, to estimate when the mentioned forms will be mailed. Every effort, however, will be made to shorten the time between now and the date of mailing and your desires will be acted upon with a minimum of delay.
