The casualty message received from the Commanding General of the European Theater of Operations stated that Private Edwin J. Stachowski, Army serial number 35 343 780, Infantry, was killed in action 1 July 1944 in France. Additional records have now been received which confirm this report and show that he died as the result of a gunshot wound of the left chest. Unfortunately, no further details regarding his death were given.

The Adjutant General has forwarded to this office, for further reply, your inquiry relative to the burial location of Private Edwin J. Stachowski.

The official records disclose that the remains of Private Stachowski were interred in the United States Military Cemetery, Blosville, France, Grave 84, Now 5, Plot E. This cemetery is located approximately twenty miles northwest of St. Lo, twenty-four miles southeast of Cherbourg and five miles north and slightly west of Carentan, all in France.

It may be a consolation to the family to know that plans are being formulated to return the remains of our honored dead to the legal next of kin, who will be contacted by this office, after legislation has been enacted, to ascertain their wishes as to the final disposition of the remains of their loved ones. All expenses incident to the preparation, casketing and shipment to the place thus designated will be borne by the Government.

The Acting Quartermaster General, Major General C. L. Corbin, desires to extend through you to the family his deepest sympathy in the loss their son.
