Dear Mr. Williams:

The Department of the Army desires that you be given the most recent information concerning your son, the late Private Hugh F. Williams, ASN 33 632 922.

His remains were initially buried with others of his comrades who met their death in the same incident. Since that time the American Graves Registration Service has, without success, explored every clue that might lead to individual identification of any of the remains, and has at last been forced to conclude that only a group identification of the remains is possible. They are now casketed and, pending return to the United States, are being held overseas.

All remains in this group will be brought back simultaneously for interment in Long Island National Cemetery, located at Farmingdale, New York.

This plan for the burial of all the known groups of men for whom individual identity cannot be established in one of our country's shrines is based upon the provisions of Public Law 383, 79th Congress, as amended by Section 3, Public Law 368, 80th Congress. Final interment in a National Cemetery in the United States where perpetual care will be given the graves, is fitting and proper. This particular National Cemetery was selected in order that no undue burden of travel might be placed on any one family wishing to attend the services.

You and the next of kin of the other men will be informed of the date and time of the final interment sufficiently in advance to permit you and any interested persons to attend the ceremonies. In order that you may receive information concerning these final rites, it is essential, in case you change your address, that you promptly inform the Commanding General, New York Port of Embarkation, Attention AGRD, First Avenue and 58th Street, Brooklyn, New York.

Information obtained from the Casualty files only show that Private Williams was killed in action on 6 June 1944 in France.

Information obtained from Historical files show the following:

The mission of the 101st Airborne Division was to seize four principal causeways or exits from the beaches on which Seaborne forces were to land, and expedite the landing of the Seaborne troops. The 506th Parachute Infantry was given the mission of seizing two exits--Exit #1 passing through Pouppeville, a small town five miles northeast of Carentan, on the Contentin Peninsula, -- Exit #2 approximately 3000 yards north of the first. In addition one Battalion of the 506th was detailed to seize two bridges across the Douve river east of Carentan, and prevent the enemy from crossing toward the north.

First Battalions objective was Ste. Marie-du-Mont(414928)coord.

Second Battalions objective was the two exits mentioned above, Exit #1--through Pouppeville (439931) and exit #2 (431946)coord.

Third Battalions objective was the two bridges mentioned above at approx.--(430878)coord.

Pvt. Williams was killed in action during the above first Bn. attack on the above mentioned town on the 6 June 1944.
