GUESTS OF SENATOR ROBERT D. ROBBINS
ON BEHALF OF SENATOR TERRY L.
PUNT PRESENTED TO THE SENATE**

The PRESIDENT. The Chair recognizes the gentleman from Mercer, Senator Robbins.

Senator ROBBINS. Madam President, today I have the honor of making an introduction on behalf of Senator Punt, and I have the honor of introducing a true American hero. With us today to celebrate his 81st birthday is Mr. Robert Gehrett, a man who risked his life under the most horrific conditions to ensure the freedoms we enjoy today. Mr. Gehrett attended the Aviations Mechanic School in Harrisburg at the onset of World War II. Upon completing his schooling, he became an aviations mechanic at the Middletown Air Depot. It was while working in this capacity that he was drafted in the United States Army. He joined Army engineer training at Fort Leonardwood, and it was here that he volunteered for duty with the 101st Airborne Division, which was immortalized in the film "Band of Brothers." Mr. Gehrett, in fact, went to jump school at Fort Benning, Georgia, with Dick Winters. He was initially assigned to the 502nd Parachute Infantry Regiment Headquarters Company, and was the squad leader of a heavy weapons squad. He went to Europe with the 101st Airborne on the Queen Mary.

On D-Day, June 6, 1944, Mr. Gehrett, along with 13,000 of his fellow paratroopers, parachuted into Normandy, 6 miles behind enemy lines at Ste.-Me're-Eglise. Eighty percent of those men were either killed or wounded in combat. This invasion, as we know today, helped turn the tide of the war. He also participated in Operation Market Garden, jumping with the 502nd into Holland. Mr. Gehrett was assigned to B Company of the 2nd of the 501st Parachute Infantry Regiment. He also participated in the Battle of the Bulge, starting on the 17th of December, and in temperatures well below freezing, he suffered from frostbite and was hospitalized at that time. He was sent to England and did not rejoin the 101st Airborne Division, but the Army took the training he originally started with and utilized his aviation mechanics training and he was transferred to the 8th Army Air Corps.
