

My dear Major General:

I am writing in the interest of my daughter, Mrs. Yolanda Doris Bogart, widow of Captain Loyal K. Bogart No. 0467440, Infantry, who has been reported killed in action on June 11, 1944 in France. This date of death was confirmed by you per letter of May 16, 1945.

We thought that perhaps by this time, you would have some further information regarding the death of Captain Bogart - as to whether you actually have concrete evidence that Captain Bogart was killed in action and the location and other information as to place of burial.

We should very much like to have this information, especially since a friend of mine is leaving for Europe very shortly on a business trip and he has consented to visit his grave if we could give him the necessary information. We understand also that upon request of the family, the Government will bring the body to the United States for burial. We should, therefore, appreciate further information regarding this matter.

We have upon two occasions received personal belongings of Captain Bogart, consisting of clothing and uniforms which he left behind in England, but we have received nothing whatsoever of personal effects which had been on his person at time of death. We appreciate that personal belongings are usually taken and retained by the enemy, but we wonder whether there has been any belongings that were on his person at time of death that can be transmitted to the widow. Any information that you can give us regarding the death of Captain Bogart will be greatly appreciated.





The Army Effects Bureau has received some personal effects belonging to your husband, Captain Loyal E. Bogart.

This property is being forwarded to you in a footlocker and should reach you in the near future.

My action in transmitting the property does not, of itself, vest title in you. The items are forwarded in order that you may act as gratuitous bailee in caring for them pending the return of the owner, who has been reported missing in action. In the event he later is reported a casualty, and I sincerely hope he never is, it will be necessary that the property be turned over to the person or persons legally entitled to receive it.

My dear Major General:

I am writing in the interest of my daughter Mrs. Yolanda Doris Bogart, widow of Captain Loyal K. Bogart No. 0467440, Infantry. who has been reported killed in action on June 11, 1944 in France. This date of death was confirmed by you per letter of May 16. 1945.

We thought that perhaps by this time, you would have some further information regarding the death of Captain Bogart - as to whether you actually have concrete evidence that Captain Bogart was killed in action and the location and other information as to place of burial.

We should very much like to have this information, expecially since a friend of mine is leaving for Europe very shortly on a buriness trip and he has consented to visit his grave if we could give him the necessary information. We understand also that upon request of the family, the Government will bring the body to the United States for burial. "e should, therefore, appreciate further information regarding this matter.

We have upon tow occasions received personal belongings of Captain Bogart, consisting of clothing and uniforms which he left behind in England, but we have received nothing whatsoever of personal effects which has been on his person at time of death. We appreciate that personal belongings are usually taken and retained by the enemy, but we wonder whether there has been any belongings that were on his person at time of death that can be transmitted to the widow. Any information that you can give us regarding the death of Captain Bogart will be greatly appreciated

Dear Mr. D'Arcangelo:

Your letter written in the interest of your daughter, Mrs. Yolanda D. Bogart, has been forwarded to this office for direct reply, relative to the burial, personal effects and return of the remains of her husband, the late Captain Loyal K. Bogart.

The official report of interment received in this office reveals that the remains of Captain Bogart were interred in the U. S. Military Cemetery #1, Marigny, France, Plot R, Row 2, Grave 24. With reference to other larger cities the approximate location of Marigny, France is five miles west and south of St. Lo and ten miles east and north of Coutances, both in France.

In view of the fact that the Army Effects Bureau, Kansas City Quartermaster Depot, Kansas City, Missouri, has been designated to receive and ship personal effects of deceased personnel overseas, a copy of your letter has been forwarded to that office for direct reply. This action has been taken in order to expedite reply and eliminate duplication of effort.

Now that Japan has been defeated immediate plans are being formulated with a view to returning to the next of kin the remains of their loved ones. This sacred duty will be carried out by the Government at its expense and insofar as practicable in accordance with the expressed wishes of the legal next of kin, who will be notified by this office well-in advance of the actual return of the remains.

This office has been advised that an additional report has not been received in the War Department which discloses that Captain Bogart was killed in action in Graignes, France, and that his body was Identified by his identification tags. No further information was contained in the report.

Please extend to Mrs. Bogart my deepest sympathy in the loss of her husband.

The War Department is most desirous that you be furnished information regarding the burial location of your husband, the late Captain Loyal K. Bogart, A.S.N. 0 467 440.

The records of this office disclose that his remains are interred in the U.S. Military Cemetery Marigny, plot R, row 2, grave 24. You may be assured that the identification and interment have been accomplished with fitting dignity and solemnity.

This cemetery is located nine miles west of St. Lo, France, and is under the constant care and supervision of United States military personnel.

The War Department has now been authorized to comply, at Government expense, with the feasible wishes of the next of kin regarding final interment, here or abroad, of the remains of your loved one. At a later date, this office will, without any action on your part, provide all legal next of kin with full information and solicit their detailed desires.

Please accept my sincere sympathy in your great loss.

The people of the United States, through the Congress have authorized the disinterment and final burdel of the horoic dead of World War II. The Quartermenter General of the Jamy has been entrusted with this sacred responsibility to the honored dead. The records of the War Department indicate that you may be the necrest relative of the above-nessed deceased, who gave his life in the service of his country.

The enclosed peophlets, "Disposition of World War II Armed Forces Dead," and "American Compteries," explain the disposition, options and services made available to you by your Government. If you are the next of kin according to the line of kinship as set forth in the enclosed peophlet, "Disposition of World War II Armed Forces Dead," you are invited to express your vishes as to the disposition of the remains of the deceased by completing Part I of the enclosed form "Request for Disposition of Remains." Should you desire to relinquish your rights to the next in line of kinship, please complete Part II of the enclosed form. If you are not the next of kin, please complete Part III of the enclosed form.

If you should elect Option 2, it is advised that no funeral arrangements or other personal arrangements be made until you are further notified by this office.

Will you please complete the emplosed form, "Request for Disposition of Remmins" and mail in the emplosed self-addressed envelope, which requires no postage, within 30 days after its receipt by you? Its prompt return will avoid unnecessary delays.

Dear Mrs. Bogart:

This is to inform you that the remains of your loved one have been permanently interred, as recorded above, side by side with comrades who also gave their lives for their country. Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burlal.

After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments. the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the care and supervision of the American Battle Monuments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the parmament headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death. Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington 25, D. C. Your letter should include the full name, rank, serial number, grave location, and name of the cemetery.

While interments are in progress, the cenetery will not be open to visitors. You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solemnity and that the grave-site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Government.
