RIGHT THUMB	Upon reprocessing by Subordinate Identification Point # 1 Carentan, Case Unknown X-455, was found to be a mass burial of four (4) men. Because of the difference in size and structure in the bones, separation was possible. Segregation was made into cases Unknown X-455 A, B, C and D. Due to the small amount of bones recovered, the four remains were buried in one casket. No clothing was found. The teeth found were a mass common among the remains. They were all placed with remains of case A and the Tooth Chart is enclosed with case papers of case X-455 A. Original Report of burial found in debris states the following : "This body disinterred from common grave (Buried by Germans. No records. With Georges E. Tillett, 13047453, X-450, X-451, X-452, X-453, X-454, X-455 and Edward A. Bochniasz 16016671. 5 miles N W of Pont-Hebert." It is possible that consolidation can be made with any of the cases referred to in the above mentioned burial report. As no positive identifying clues were found, case remains unknown.

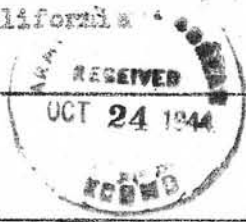

NARRATIVE

Case X-455 buried in Plot BE, Row 5, Grave 94, USMC La Cambe, was recovered as mass-burial of four men in skeletal form. The bones in all four cases were common among a mass.

The bones were laid out in anatomical order and all that remained were bones from the forearms of each case. In case A, two fibulae were recovered, a part of a right humerus and a few foot bones. The bones were measured and separated according to their size and structure.

It is possible that consolidation can be made with any of the cases referred to in below mentioned burial report.

Teeth were charted and placed with case A of this series.

No clothing was found.

A burial report was found in the debris which stated:

" This body disinterred from Common grave. ( Buried by Germans-No " " records. With George E. TILLET, 13047453, X-450, X-451, X-452, " " X-453, X-454, X-456, and Edward A. BOCHNIASZ, 16016671, 5 mi. " " north-west of Pont-Hebert. "

This case is now separated into cases X-455 A, B, C, D respectively and each case remains Unknown. They are buried in one casket, due to the small amount of bones.



As per telephone instructions from Processing Section, Headquarters ACRC, I re-examined remains of Edward A. Bochniasz (La Cambe EE-5-95). Remains consist of fractured right portion of mandible with two teeth.

This mandible does not agree with DSS Form for Bochniasz as there is no evidence of any cavity or filling in R-15. R-14 does agree as it is extracted. The fact that R-16 is listed as extracted or out on DSS Form and is shown to be present on tooth chart may be accounted for by the fact that it may have been unerrupted when DSS Form was accomplished.

Two original identification tags were found with remains of Bochniasz but as this man came from a common grave with ten other men, it appears odd that a fractured mandible could be so readily associated with two ID tags.

It is suggested that tooth charts for George E. Tillett, 13047453, Unknown X-451, X-452, X-453, X-454, X-455A, B, C, & D, and X-456 be checked to determine whether or not one of these remains are those of Bochniasz, if it is determined that his remains are not those presently identified in EE-5-95.

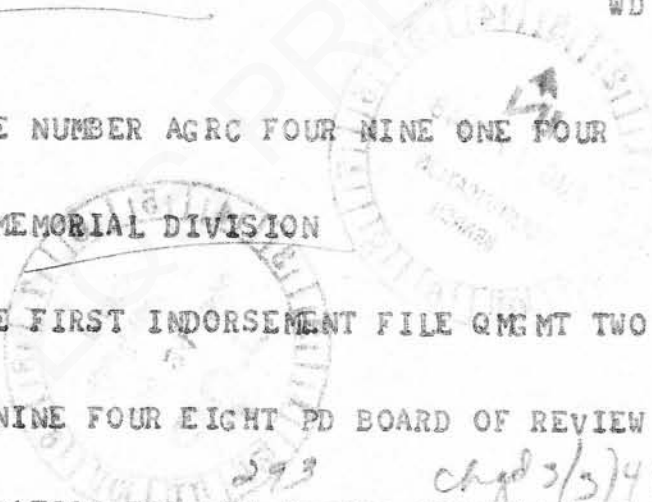

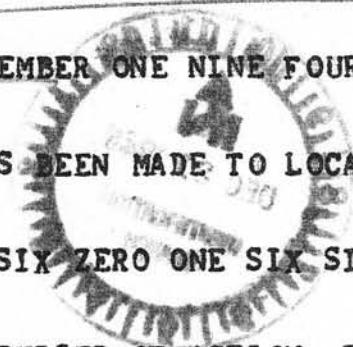

FINDINGS :

The Board having carefully considered the evidence before it :

1. - Finds the remains of X-455A were disinterred from the same common grave which contained two identification tags for Pfc Bochniasz.
2. - That the Tooth Chart for X-455A is in favorable agreement with dental records for Pfc Bochniasz.
3. - That the Tooth Charts for all remains other than X-455A, which were disinterred from the same common grave are negative to the dental records for Pfc Bochniasz.
4. - That the estimated height of X-455A is in favorable agreement with the height of Pfc Bochniasz.
5. - That no remains other than X-455A can be associated with Pfc Bochniasz,

RECOMMENDATIONS :

In view of the above findings, the Board recommends,

1. - That the remains now identified as Bochniasz, Edward, Plot BE, Row 5, Grave 95, USMC La Cambe be redesignated as Unknown.
2. - That the remains of Unknown X-455A, Plot BE, Row 5, Grave 94, La Cambe be identified as Bochniasz, Edward A, Pfc, 16016671.





## REMARKS

Remains interred in Plot BE, Row 5, Grave 95, USMC La Cambe, were previously identified as Pfc. Edward A. BOCHNIASZ, 16016671, by ID tag, however, reprocessing revealed the the remains consisted of only a partial Mandible which compared negatively with dental records for the subject deceased. In view of the fact that the remains were disinterred from a common grave with partial remains of ten (10) other deceased, re-investigation of the case was made by the Field, and resulted in the identification of Unknown X-455 A, Plot BE, Row 5, Grave 94, as Pfc. BOCHNIASZ. (See Report of Board of Officers, attached)

Place of death is in agreement.

Army Dental records for Pfc. BOCHNIASZ compare favorably with tooth chart for Unknown X-455 A and negatively with tooth charts for the other deceased recovered from the common grave.

Estimated height and color of hair are in agreement.

One ID tag for Pfc. BOCHNIASZ was found among the remains in the common grave from whence Unknown X-455 A was disinterred.

Will you please complete the enclosed form, "Request for Disposition of Remains" and mail in the enclosed self-addressed envelope, which requires no postage, within 30 days after its receipt by you? Its prompt return will avoid unnecessary delays.

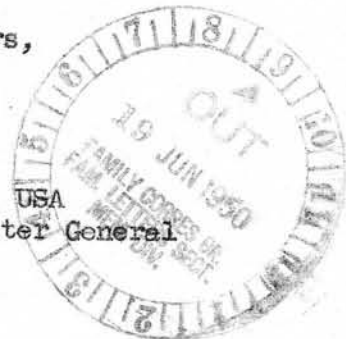
This is to inform you that the remains of your loved one have been permanently interred, as recorded above, side by side with comrades who also gave their lives for their country. Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burial.

After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the care and supervision of the American Battle Monuments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death.
