

If you should elect Option 2, it is advised that no funeral exempenents or other personal arrangements be made until you are further notified by this office.

Will you please complete the enclosed form, "Request for Disposition of Remains" end sail in the enclosed self-addressed envelope, which requires no postage, which is dear after its receipt by you! Its prompt return will evoid unnecessary delays.
