Dear George:-

At long last your efforts have been successful in trying to locate me.

Your letter sent to my home in Greeley, Colorado, was forwarded by my mother and was received yesterday.

I don't believe I have to tell you that it was indeed a great pleasure receiving your letter and to know what it is that you are doing with regard to this book.

When you answer this letter please put Stub Shrodo's address in it so as to allow me to drop him a note.

Sitting down last night, reading your letter and talking to my wife, it has been 22 years almost to the day when we made our big jump.

You are correct that one of the Bangers in Denver, Colo., is one of my relatives. He happens to be my oldest brother, Franklin E. Banger.

I was quite surprised that you had located Herbert Zichuhr and got quite a chuckle that he remembered me as a tall skinny kid.

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At that time I was about 6-1/2 and weighed 190 lbs. Today I am 6-2 and weigh 247 lbs. Fortunately you put the "tall skinny kid" in quotes, which certainly filled the bill.

It is correct on the jump into Normandy. My chute streamed and I dropped about 90 feet. I fractured my hip, pubic bone, and cracked my ribs, broke my right arm and dislocated my right shoulder. I was finally found by a Patrol around noon of June 8 and was evacuated to England. I eventually got out of the hospital on time to ride a glider into Holland and managed to come thru that campaign in good shape. Was captured on December 19 at Bastogne and spent the rest of the time in prison. I might add, if I remember correctly, that our Jump Master that evening was Major Larry LeGere, who is now Col. LeGere, and the last information I had he was located at the Pentagon in Washington, D.C.

I am certainly interested in receiving a copy of the Jump Manifest as it has been a long time since I have given any thought to what might have happened to all of the men that made that jump that day. from our plane.

I am looking forward very much to hearing from you and answering your questionnaire. Any help that I can give you in the way of information in the writing of this book I will be most happy to do so.

Upon my discharge from the service I entered the University of Nebraska, graduating in 1950. Taught school for 2-1/2 years in Sioux City, Iowa, and then moved to Omaha, Nebraska, and went to work for a heavy construction equipment company and have been with them for the past 12 years.

It was certainly good to hear from you, George, and I am happy that you took the time to locate me.
