33rd CHEMICAL DECOMPANY TO CARRY OUP ANY ASSIGNED SHOKE MISSION

- 1. Immediately upon arrival on the far shore the Chemical Company will send one officer and one enlisted man to the CP of the AA Defense Command. After analyze contact with AA Defense Command the officer will return to the Company and the collisted man will remain to act as lighten between AA Defense Command and the Company.
- 2. At Defense Command will clear any request for smoke through Brigade He so that Brigade may have the opportunity of vetcing it, should they feel smoke would interfere with normal beach operations.
- 3. As soon as the tectical situation permits, an officer from the Chemical Decontamination Company and the recommaissance section will recommende maintenance areas and will select points for placing fog generators so as to cover any point in area, either with an offanore or cross shore wind.
- 4. Hisison will be established on D day between the Brigade Chamical Officer and the Chamical Documentation Company. The Brigade Chamical Officer will check 52 and AA weather reports each day so that the company can be informed as to any shift in wind direction or other weather conditions that may interfere with amoke mission.
- 5. Upon the assignment of a fog mission the company less personnel necessary to operate CMS dump will reorganize into a Hq Flatoon, three fog generator platoons consisting of two operating sections and one supply and maintenance section each.
- 6. Additional trucks necessary to maintain supply of fog oil and petrol to generator line will be drawn from brigade.
- 7. Existing communication including those at AA gun emplacements will be utilized to coordinate the proper employment of the amoke screen.
- 8. After D / 6 when 24 additional generators become available, a complete generator line will be established around entire area and smoke can be produced in any or all parts of Brigade area on call.

- I. Lt. Wright and Cpl. Daniels will report to Capt. McStay at Brigade C.P. upon arrival at far shore.
- II. Lt. Donnelly and Gp. Vona will establish Leison with AAA C.P.
