Pfc Charles G. Stout, ASN 15114250, Infantry

TO : Effects Quartermaster, Communication Zone, U. S. Army

1. Received the effects or personal belongings of Pfc.  
George G. Stout, ASN 15114250, Infantry, from the Provost Marshal,  
9th AAF Service Command, France, this date, the following:

- ✓ a. Wallet, with snapshots.
- ✓ b. Soldier's Individual Pay Record Book.
- ✓ c. Part of Flight Record or Aircraft Service Record.

2. The Provost Marshal stated "The wallet was found at  
Map Coordinate 165-083, on map scale 1-50000, on or about D / 3,  
near the wreckage of a C-47A, an American Aircraft". He also  
stated that "After questioning the French people in the locality,  
he was shown the graves of those who perished in the plane crash.  
The French people buried the bodies". Furthermore, he stated that  
"The Army Graves Registration Section at Master QM was given the  
grid coordinates and map scale so that the bodies could be taken  
care of and identified".
