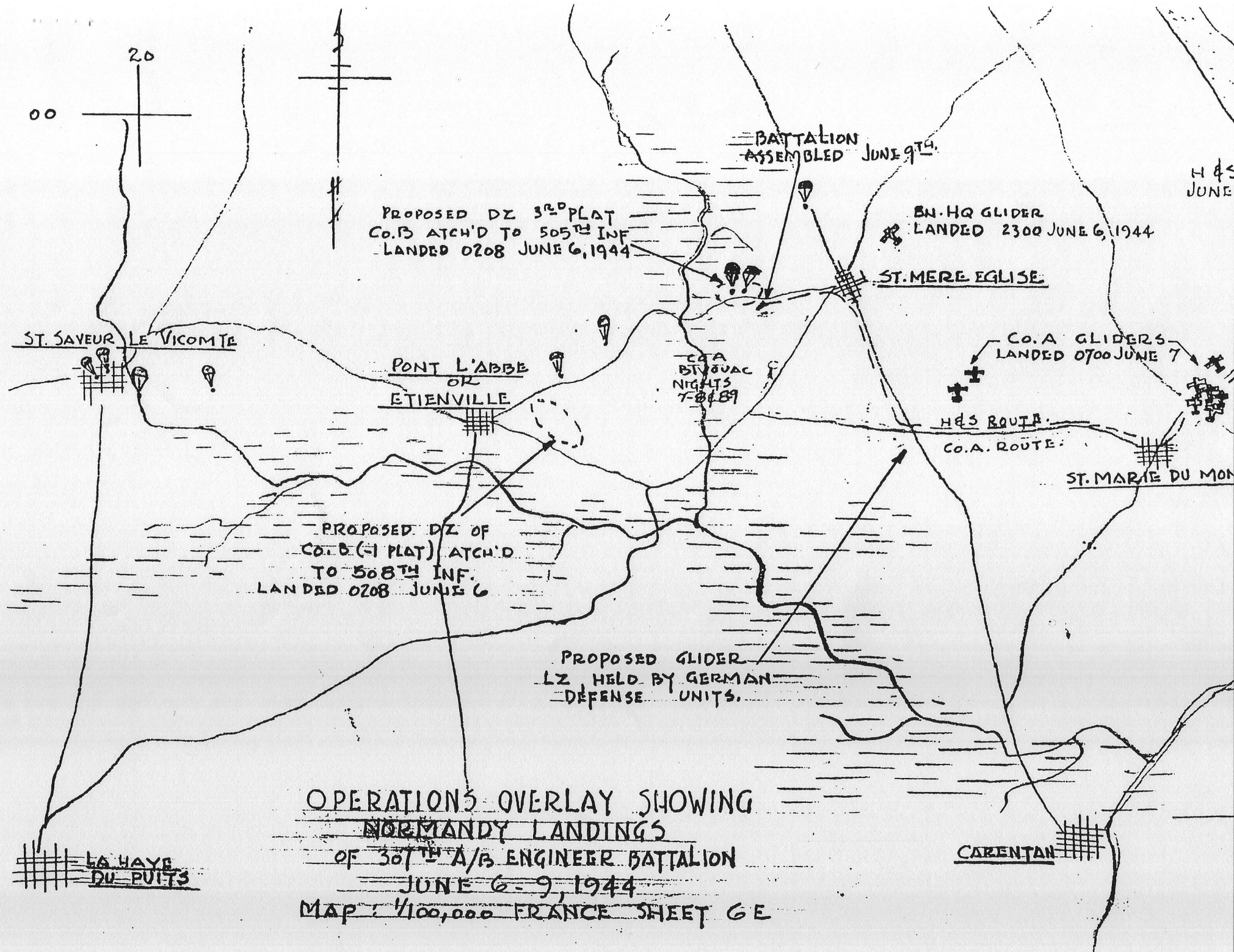

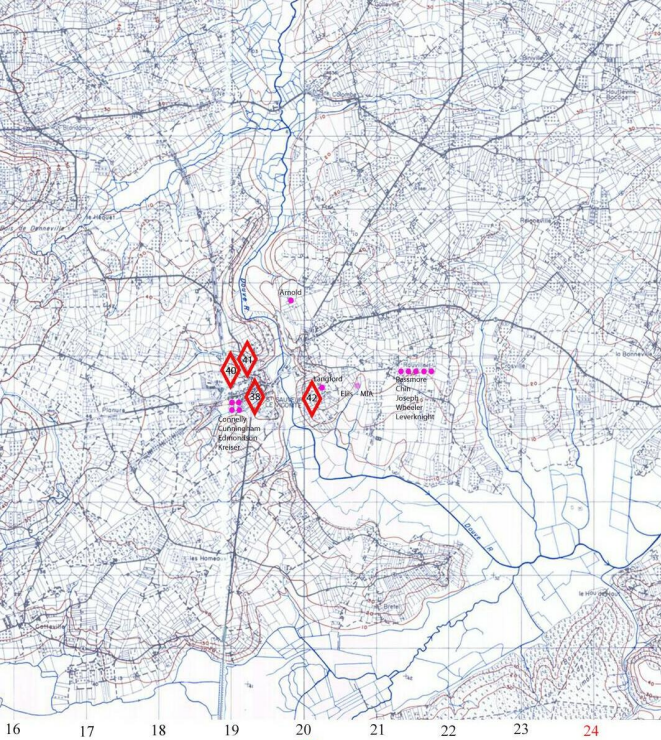

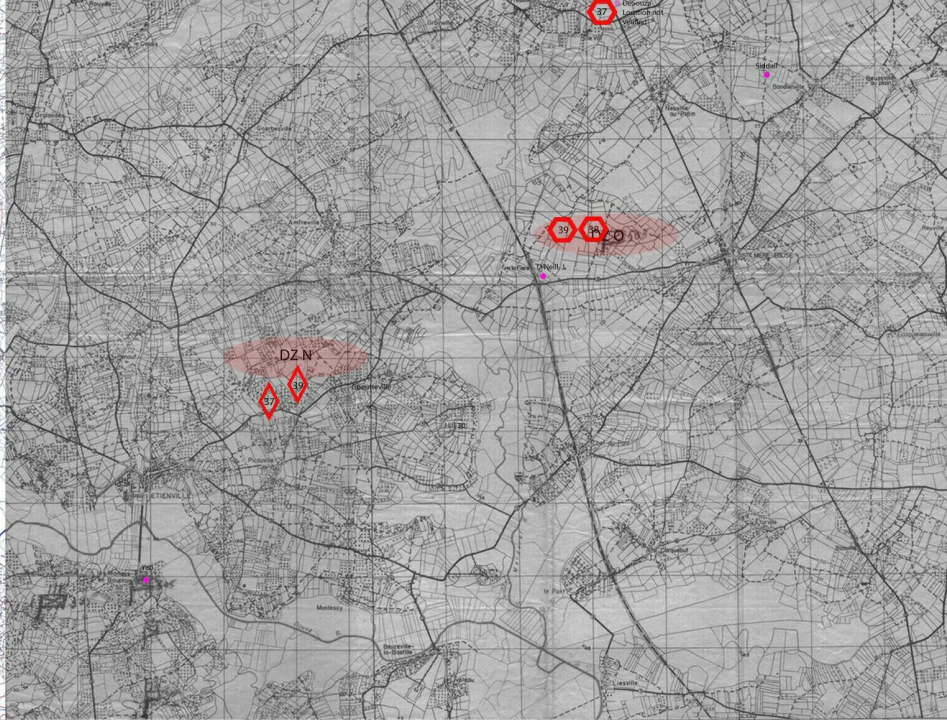

This should be my last post for today. Soldier on the right (our left) William Yeo, on right Glen (Tex) Pultz. This was taken in Naples right before Tex was killed. Yeo was killed 11 June 1944. They were best friends and Tex Pultz Parkway is named after Glen. In one of those strange twists of fate just before Yeo got on his plane on the way to Normandy he spoke with Leslie Kick and told Kick he wasn't coming back from Normandy. Leslie Kick and Glen Putiz were both from Port Byron, NY. (Photo came from Glen's sister Mrs. Seamans).

Even stranger was my uncle Elmer Quentin Siddall came in as a replacement for Normandy for the 23 Soldiers Killed on October 10, 1943 in Naples for Co B. Not only was my uncle from the same county I went to school in Port Byron and in the mid-80's I was working for Tex Pultz's nephew in Auburn, NY but we didn't know that until 2005.

The last strange coincidence is on the Morning Report attached. Both Siddall and Yeo are right in a row on that MR. Back in 1943 and 1944 it was a small world indeed. I would still like to find a relative for Bill Yeo but so far no luck. He was from Philadelphia, PA but his one brother is gone and that's where the trail ends.
